The 2009 Corvettes in Paradise will be held at the MIRAMAR AT WAIKIKI. The Miramar at Waikiki is in the “Heart” of Waikiki at 2345 Kuhio Avenue.

Other restaurants within the area are:

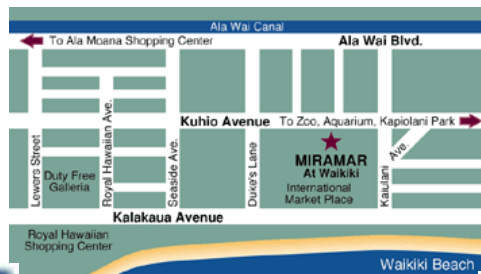
- Chili’s (across the street)

CORVETTES IN PARADISE (CIP) - EVENTS

CONCOURS — Karen Reed

Concours is the focal point of CIP and should be viewed as competitive, but fun. Cars are displayed by class and judged based on cleanliness. Judging for the Concours is done by an independent group of judges who are chosen by sponsor.

Concours will occur on Saturday, 5 September 2009. Each car will be judged strictly based on cleanliness so that everyone will have a fair chance. Judging will begin at 10:00 am.

Winners will be announced and presented with awards at the Awards Banquet on Sunday, 6, September 2009. Awards are also presented for: Judges Choice (chosen by the judges), People's Choice (voted on by the general public) and Best in Show (the highest points total for vehicles entered in Group 1).

Most members get up early the morning of the Concours to complete any last minute preparation. All cleaning must be completed ½ hour prior to judging. Members are asked to stay near their cars to assist the judges when needed.

Concours Classifications 2009

Group I–Show Class: This class is for Corvettes with limited use and prepared to traditional Concours d'Elegance standards. All entries will be judged on interior, exterior and engine compartment and technical inspection. Sub-Classes will be determined based on the number of cars being judged in the Show Class Division. Awards will be given in each Sub-Class.

Group II–Show & Go Class: This class is for Corvettes driven on a regular basis and prepared for the Concours. This class is for those who wish to show their Corvettes, but do not have the time to prepare the vehicle for traditional Concours standards. These vehicles must be regularly driven over 2000 miles per year, i.e. the daily driver. Vehicles must show normal wear and tear based on its mileage. Minor non-stock modifications such as after market wheels, air cleaners, appropriate replacement engine or other components and other non-stock accessory items will be accepted in this class. Primary emphasis will be on cleanliness, condition and mechanical completeness. All entries will be judged on technical inspection and any two of the following areas: engine compartment, interior or exterior. The owner will select areas when signing in for the Concours.

Sub-Class A 1953 – 1962

Sub-Class B 1963 – 1967

Sub-Class C 1968 – 1982

Sub-Class D 1984 – 1996

Sub-Class E 1997 – 2004

Sub-Class F 2005 – Present

Group III–Non-Stock Class: This class is for Corvettes with significant body modifications, race modifications or other special features that are not allowed for competition in the Show Class or the Show & Go Class. All models and years will compete as one class.

FUNCANA – Lee Lewis

Funcana is a fun event that is held sometime during the weekend of CIP. It is a fun, mild obstacle course or game that is kept secret until the start of the event. It is planned and devised by the sponsor(s) in charge of this event. Therefore, it can change from year to year.

Sponsor(s) are left on their own to come up with fun ideas for this event which is designed for 100% participation. Keep in mind, it should indeed be something that you will want to place high on your priority list of “Things to Do” while you are at Corvettes in Paradise.

This year’s Funcana will be held on Saturday night in the Banana Patch Room in the lobby. Winners of the Funcana this year will be announced and awarded prizes following the event.
